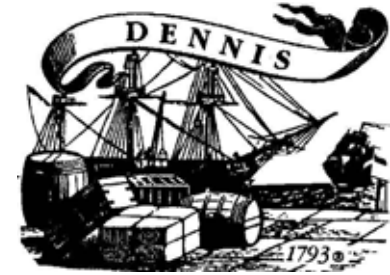

Code of Ethics and Termination Procedure:

The member will conduct him/herself in accordance with the public interest and will adopt and follow a code of professional ethics that will discourage behavior inconsistent with the image of the Dennis Chamber of Commerce.
